SUNDT FOUNDATION DONATES OVER \$163,000 TO PHOENIX-AREA NONPROFITS

TEMPE, Ariz. (September 5, 2018) – The Sundt Foundation has donated over \$163,000 in grant awards to nearly 60 local charities in the last six months.
