LIMITATIONS ON ACCESS TO SUNDT JOBSITES



Effective immediately, no employee-owner, subcontractor, supplier or vendor who meets any of the following conditions should enter any jobsite:

- Anyone returning from a **high-risk area**, or from any cruise, or anyone who, during the past 14 days, has been in contact with an in-the-home family member returning from such travel (see <u>coronavirus.gov</u>).
- Anyone who has had **close contact** with someone who has traveled to a high-risk country in the past 14 days or who has been either diagnosed with or is being tested for COVID-19. ("Close contact" means being within 6 feet of a symptomatic individual; living in the same household as or caring for a symptomatic individual.)
- Anyone who currently has, or in the last 5 days has had, a **fever greater than 100° F** (37.8° C), a persistent cough, or an acute (new) respiratory illness causing shortness of breath.

If a person is identified as meeting any of these conditions, they should be removed from a project site or site office. Also, it is recommended that they undergo a 14-day self-quarantine and, if necessary, seek appropriate medical attention.

Additionally, Sundt asks all its employee-owners to take precautions as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention:

- Regularly disinfecting and wiping down all work areas, especially commonly touched surfaces.
 - » As of Wednesday, March 18, all jobsites have been sent extra cleaning supplies.
- Frequently washing hands and using hand sanitizer.
- Avoiding contact with those who may be sick.
- Implement social distancing measures:
 - » Limit meetings to no more than 10 people.
 - » If in-person meetings are necessary, they should include only essential attendees and be held in an outside area (if possible) with at least 6 feet between each person.
 - » Hold video chats and phone calls rather than in-person meetings when possible.
